

Coloured Ice Activities

5 Fun Learning Activities Using Ice!

Coloured Ice Painting - Create a tray of coloured ice cubes by adding several drops of food colouring to the water in each segment. Once frozen, invite your child to use the cubes on paper to draw and 'paint' with.

Coloured Ice Structures - Create a variety of coloured ice blocks by filling different sized tupperware with water and food colouring. Once frozen invite your child to create structures. To 'stick' the blocks together provide your child with a spray bottle of water to spray on the ice and 'glue' them together.

Coloured Ice Play - Fill a shallow bin or sink with water and a variety of coloured ice cubes for your child to measure, scoop, pour and explore in this chilly sensory fun!

Fizzing Coloured Cubes - Mix equal amounts of water and baking soda and pour into an ice cube tray. Add a few drops of food colouring to each segment and freeze! Provide a spray bottle with vinegar in it for your child to spray their cubes and explore the chemical reaction.

Coloured Ice Mix - Invite your child to mix colours with coloured ice cubes. Supply your child with primary coloured ice cubes to put together and examine new colours that are formed.
