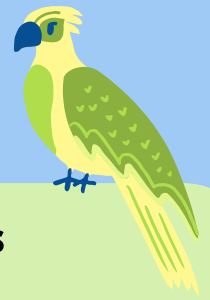
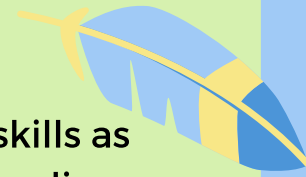


Feather Fun!

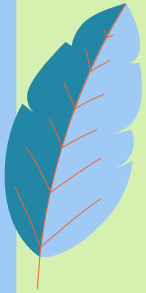


One simple item = endless learning opportunities

Feather Painting - Feathers can be a fun tool for painting. Offer your child one feather or a bunch of feathers as an alternative to a paintbrush. Match the coloured feather to the paint for an added colour recognition opportunity.



Colour Match - Invite your child to work on their fine motor skills as well as matching by pairing coloured feathers with corresponding buttons. Encourage your child to lace the colourful buttons onto their feather.



Rainbow Feathers - Provide your child with a shallow bin filled with colourful feathers to explore. Add scoops and bowls for a fun sorting activity.

Bird Feather Fun - Take binoculars on your walk for your child to look at your neighborhood up close!

Bead Count - Get your child lacing with feathers and beads. Encourage your child to fill their feather with colourful beads in the same colour or patterns.

Rubbings - Encourage your child to take 'prints' of a variety of feathers. Place a feather under a piece of paper and rub on top of the paper with the side of a crayon to create a beautiful picture!
