

# Fun Scarf Activities

Turn your walks with your child into a fun learning experience with activities below!

**Wipe Container Pull** - Fill an empty wipe container with colourful scarves for your child to pull out, explore and play. Your child will be excited to see what colour comes next and can easily open the lid to refill and pull again.

**Get up and Dance** - Tie a ribbon or long piece of tulle to a plastic shower curtain ring to create a whimsical accessory for dancing. Put on some energizing music to get your little one grooving as they wave and sway their ribbon.

**Scarf Bin** - Create a textured scarf sensory bin by filling a shallow plastic container with a selection of infinity scarves. Add a few containers with lids for your child to explore, feel, fill and play.

**Scarf Weave** - Offer your child a number of scarves to weave back and forth through the banister poles. This activity provides your child with numerous fine motor benefits.
