



Fun With Sticks

One simple item = endless learning opportunities!

Stick Boat - Build a boat using sticks and yarn. Get outdoors with your child for this adventure as you collect suitable sticks to use in building. Provide your child with yarn to use in the assembly. This activity will encourage your child to 'engineer' a boat to float. Test the boat in a shallow pond, puddle or bathtub!

Paint Them - Explore a different creative experience by inviting your child to paint on a stick. While on a walk or hike, encourage your child to choose a perfect stick on which to create their designs.

Create Letters - Learning your ABC's in a variety of ways appeals to all little learners. Provide your child with a basket of small sticks and letter cards to recreate. Lay out cards to represent their name to further their knowledge!

Make a Wand - Wands are an exciting addition to any imaginary play. Invite your child to decorate a special stick with streamers, string and a little glitter glue for some wand sparkle. Encourage your child to put on a magic show or create a dance with their whimsical wand!
