

Fun things to do with a Cardboard Box

Box bowling (stand boxes up) and invite your child to try to knock them down with a ball or bean bag.



Make box shoes and invite your child to move around while wearing them. Play music to have a 'Box' dance party.



Cut slits in the top of the box and colour each opening a different colour. Encourage your child to push corresponding coloured buttons or popsicle sticks into the holes.



Use a couple of small boxes to make a costume, encourage your child to put on a play with their box creation.



Invite your child to create a mini cardboard village or city for their stuffies or small toys.



Make wings out of the box by cutting the flaps off and attach to your child's arms so they can pretend to fly.



Use it as a drum, guitar or other musical instrument.



Create a puppet theatre.



Make a train and pretend to be the conductor or the passenger.



Play inside the box, draw all over it and create a fun fort.



Convert a cardboard box into simple race lanes for your little one to use for their race cars.
