

Muffin Pan Fun!



One item = endless learning opportunities!

Colour Sorting Tool - Cut out a different coloured piece of construction paper to fit in the bottom of each muffin section. Provide your child with coloured cereal, buttons, pom poms or small coloured items for them to match and count.

Geoboard - Create this low prep activity with elastic bands and a muffin tin. Encourage your child to pull and stretch the elastic bands over the muffin cups to create patterns with the various colours.

Magnetic Experimenting - Provide your child with a muffin tin and a variety of magnetic objects to stick in and on the tray. Alphabet letters, numbers or shapes create fun learning elements to the experiment.

Algorithm Fun - Turn the tray upside down and cover each cup with a piece of paper labelled with directional arrows. Encourage your child to hop through follow the arrows with a small toy person or animal.

Muffin Prints - The underside of the tray creates an interesting vessel to create a piece of art. Encourage your child to paint the circles with a variety of colours and press a piece of paper on top to capture the print.

Textured Ball Sort - Offer your child a variety of sized and textured balls to be able to feel and test if they fit into the cups!
