

Texture Busy Bag

Busy bags are small activities or special toys that you keep separate from other toys and games and you can pull them out for a different activity when you really need them.

Materials Needed:

- ➡ Small pencil case or used wipe container
- ➡ Textured Items - felt, cotton balls, sponges, popsicle sticks - items with a variety of textures

Directions: Create this busy bag by placing items into a container or small pencil case for your child to easily open and remove items to feel and put back in.

Everything in the bag should be very different and your child will enjoy pulling everything out and touching it all. Encourage your child to explain the textures and colours with their words.

Learning Value: This activity promotes sensory and learning by encouraging your child to focus on their fine motor and tactile skills while they explore the materials provided.
