



Winter Outdoor Play



Chilly weather activities to keep your child active!

Animal Ice Rescue - This quick and easy animal ice rescue activity is the perfect outdoor sensory table activity for all ages.

Simply freeze toy animals in an ice cube tray filled with coloured water. Then, let child use water sprayers to rescue their animal friends.

Ice Ornaments - Fill a shallow container with natural treasures such as leaves, berries or pine cones and add a few inches of water. Return on the second day to observe what happened - take the frozen disks out of the container and hang them in the trees as decorations.

Snow Painting - Fill a watering can, spray bottle, or even a pop bottle (with a hole poked into the lid) with coloured water. Add a few drops of food colouring to allow your child to create art in the snow.

Frozen Bubbles - Blow a bubble with ordinary bubble blowing solution. If the temperature is low enough (below freezing) the bubble will freeze after a few moments. Be sure to catch it on your wand before it freezes so you can pop it and watch it shatter.

Potato Head Snow Creations - Take your potato head toys outside to encourage your child to create tiny snow people! Using the play eyes and toy hats, your child will enjoy designing a snow village.
